

FLORIDA KEYS GEAR LIST - WINTER

CLOTHING

- 2 pair Pants/Jeans
- 4 pair Shorts
- 5 T-Shirts
- 2 Swimsuits
- 6 pair Socks
- 1 pair Tennis Shoes
- 1 pair Water Shoes *****
- Windbreaker (rain jacket can double for this)
- 5 Underwear
- Sweater / Sweatshirt (fleece or wool)

COMMISSARY ITEMS

- Plastic Bowl and/or Plate
- Eating Utensils
 - Plastic Cup

GEAR NEEDS

- Duffle Bag or similar soft bag/luggage
- Sleeping Bag *****
- Sleeping Pad (1/4" ensolite)
- Flashlight with extra Batteries
- 2 Nalgene water bottles quart-size
- Insect Repellent (non-aerosol)
- Pen and Paper
- 50' nylon cord (small diameter)***
- Rain Gear**
- Day Pack
- Sunscreen (maximum protection)
- Pillow

PERSONAL NEEDS

- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Deodorant
 - Soap/Soapbox
- 2 Bath Towels
 - 1 Washcloth

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

- Disposable Camera (optional)
- Fishing Pole (optional)
- Binoculars (optional)
- Diving Mask *
- Snorkel*
- Diving Fins*

NOTES

1. All clothing and personal effects should be labeled.
 2. Jewelry, valuable watches and radios should be left at home.
 3. All knives (other than a table knife) must be left at home.
- * These items may be rented at a dive shop in the Keys for approximately \$15.00 for the duration of the course. Bring your own if you have them. They are necessary for the enjoyment of the trip.
- ** Quality rain gear is essential. Please consult your local outdoor retailer with any questions.
- *** This is cord used in a camping setting for clothesline, lashing gear, etc. It is NOT used for climbing!
- **** Rated for 40 degrees +/- 10 degrees (no cotton or down).
- ***** Purchase water shoes with buckles – no Velcro straps please.
